2010, a vintage with a great deal of sunshine, typical of outstanding vintages

Despite a cold spell in late May/early June and major variations in temperature, the winter of 2009-2010 and the growing season that followed were marked by **very favorable weather**.

Bud break became widespread in the latter part of April and was fairly even. Véraison began in late July and took place slowly and **fairly evenly**.

Harvest started on the 27th of September. The quality of the grapes was **excellent** thanks to a **meticulous work** done in the vineyard combined with a **very favorable weather** during the year.

Château Beychevelle 2010 has a very deep colour. The wine is tremendously fruity. The well-focused acidity makes for a superb balance and great ageing potential.
